Ben Ove Fjellin, being duly sworn, deposes and says:

1. I reside in Copenhagen, Denmark.
2. I have a law degree from University of Copenhagen and have practiced law in Denmark for **10** years. One of the areas of my practice is Danish inheritance law with which I am well versed.
3. I have reviewed the original duly stamped *Probate Court Certificate for Administration out of Court* with apostille issued by the court of Retten **Sveby**, Danmarks Domstole docket number sks **KS 756/2019** dated **30 January 2020** ("the Probate Certificate").
4. The Probate Certificate shows that **Peter Juel Bonnicman** and **Kiti Juel Lindhardt** are the sole beneficiaries of the decedent's estate and that they may administer the estate.
5. I have also reviewed decedent's death certificate issued by the U.S. Department of State, U.S. Embassy showing decedent's permanent or temporary address in **Sveby**, Denmark.
6. Upon the basis of the documentation submitted to me, it is my considered opinion, based upon Danish law, that:

(a) The Retten [REDACTED] Court has proper jurisdiction of this estate;

(b) The proceedings in that Court are proper in all respects;

(c) [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] are the Danish equivalent of co-administrators of the entire estate of the decedent, and they each have the power to administer the estate of the decedent in Denmark in accordance with The Danish Act of Handling of Death Estates §44 where the applicable provision of Danish Law in pertinent part reads as follows:

“...When the decedent’s estate has been released to the administrator of the estate, the administrator immediately takes possession of the assets or secures such assets against unauthorized measures...”

7. I have examined all of the Danish documents submitted in connection with the Petition for Ancillary Letters of Administration CTA and I do hereby certify that said documents were authenticated and attested in the manner prescribed by the laws of the Kingdom of Denmark.
8. [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] are fully authorized and empowered pursuant to the laws of the Kingdom of Denmark to execute the Waivers of Citation submitted herein authorizing and appointing [REDACTED] Ancillary Administrator, CTA. Furthermore, [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] have the right to waive issuance of a Citation.
